Personally, I'm excited about the ways Mosaic Network provides opportunity for collaboration and empowers Mosaic Network ministers through fiscal sponsorship and resources to offer spiritual formation care to the leaders and communities God has placed on their hearts to serve.

In February, Mosaic Formation had the privilege of leading a spiritual retreat and training to a group of diverse and influential ministry leaders around South Africa in partnership with Mosaïek Church and Renovaré. One of the joys of this trip was the opportunity to collaborate with Jovin Adjeitey of Tapestry Soul Care, who traveled from Ghana, West Africa, to help co-lead this retreat.
